24th Sunday: Forgiveness heals

“Forgiveness is the needle that knows how to mend,” Jewel

On May 13, 1981, Pope St. John Paul II was shot and critically wounded in an assassination attempt while greeting a crowd of roughly 20,000 worshippers in St. Peter's Square, Vatican City. Despite the fact that the Pope was struck multiple times by bullets, sustaining severe wounds to his abdomen, left hand, and arm; he miraculously survived the ordeal.

In December 1983, millions watched on television as the Pope visited Mehmet Ali Agca, the man who attempted to assassinate him a few years back. The white-robed Pope and Mehmet huddled in the cell for 21 minutes, talking in low voices that could not be heard. St. John Paul after the visit relayed his conversation with the prisoner to the media; he said, “I spoke to a brother whom I have forgiven.”

Marianne Williamson said, “Forgiveness is not always easy. At times, it feels more painful than the wound we suffered, to forgive the one that inflicted it. And yet, there is no peace without forgiveness.”

Today's gospel deals with a subject which concerns us all - forgiveness. None of us can go through life without getting hurt. How do we cope with these hurts? They can provide us with an opportunity to grow, or they can become a stumbling block to our human and spiritual development.

It is very important to clean out the cellar of the mind and heart, from time to time.

The cobwebs of hurts have to be swept away. Forgiveness is first and foremost **a healing of our own hearts**. It is precisely our hearts that are wounded. In forgiving others, we rid ourselves of the burden of bitterness and resentment. As a result, we experience a sense of freedom and relief.

Moreso, forgiveness implies an understanding of our own poverty, brokenness, and sin, and therefore our own need of forgiveness. This enables us to forgive with understanding and humility. It is not enough to forgive in word. We must forgive, as Jesus said, from the heart.

It is not a question of forgiving if and when the offender repents - that would be relatively easy. We are expected to forgive even if the offender never asked for it -

this is what makes it so difficult. (*cf. Matthew 5:44*)

The first step towards forgiveness is the willingness to say ‘Yes, I forgive.’ It really takes a lot of courage to forgive. The second step is to ask for the help of God by admitting, ‘God, I really want to forgive, but I do not know how to forgive; help me to forgive totally and completely from the depth of my heart.’

When we forgive, we benefit a lot:

- forgiveness frees us from unnecessary burdens
- it is physically and spiritually healthy
- it puts one above the offender
- it fosters unity and love
- our life depends on God’s mercy and forgiveness

Forgiveness clears a path for God to forgive us (*cf.* Matthew 6:12-15). Taking a clue from the prayer “Our Father” - the only obstacle we can put in the way of God’s forgiveness of our sins is our inability to forgive the sins of others. We all need forgiveness. People who cannot forgive break down the bridge over which they themselves must pass.
