May is the Month of the Our Lady

It is a centuries-old custom of Catholics to dedicate the month of May to the Blessed Virgin Mary. The month of May is always part of the Easter season, the fifty days we celebrate in the liturgy the Resurrection of Our Lord, a time also of awaiting the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. The celebration of May as a Marian month fits well with the liturgical celebrations of Easter and Pentecost as we recall Mary's great joy in her Son's victory over death as well as her presence with the apostles in the upper room prayerfully awaiting the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

At the Visitation, Elizabeth said to Mary: Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled. When we think of our Blessed Mother, we recognize that she is indeed *blessed*, not only because she was the Mother of Jesus, but because she believed in the Lord's words. She believed with all her heart and said "yes" to become the Mother of the Messiah and Son of God. She allowed herself to be led by God's grace throughout her life, a life rooted in a deep faith in God. She became her Son's first and most perfect disciple.



4th Sunday of Easter: Belonging to his flock

The flock is an image of community. In community we find mutual support, encouragement, and companionship. We can't belong to Jesus without belonging also to his flock. When the word 'flock' is taken literally = *St. Michael's Parish, Canadian Martyrs or St. Benedict.* The privilege of belonging to Jesus' flock is not something that is offered to a chosen few, but to everyone. The feeling of belonging to, of being known and loved by Jesus, is enormously comforting and reassuring.

Jesus is the Good Shepherd. The sheep belong to him, and he is ready to die for them. The hired hand doesnot own the sheep, and runs away as soon as he sees a wolf approaching.

Who would not want to belong to his flock?What does belonging entail?

- The first is **tobelieve in him**. We enter the flock by becoming believers. But belief is only the beginning.
- The second requirement is **to listen to his voice**, 'My sheep listen to my voice' (John 10:27). To listen to his voice is to heed his teachings (in the bible and doctrines of the church).
- And the third requirement is tofollow him, 'My sheep follow me' (v. 27^b).
 To follow him is to do his word. This may be as simply as it sounds, but we are urged to obey and trust.

Jesus made the most wonderful promises to those who belong to him. He said that none of them would ever be lost. No one would succeed in snatching from his care the sheep God the Father has entrusted to him (John 10:29). The sheep that belong to him will be safe with him because the Father's power is in him. Remember, he once said 'I and the Father are one' (John 17:22). And he will lead them to the pastures of eternal life.

The sheep have to choose to belong. Jesus won't or can't save people against their will. But it is wonderfully consoling to realise that if we do sincerely want and try to belong to him, then he will take care of us in life and death. He promises to give us eternal life.

It doesn't mean that belonging to Jesus will guarantee us an easy life here on earth. The opposite is more likely to be the case. Those who belong to him are likely to be persecuted, but those who remain faithful through their trials, will share in his glory in heaven. As we celebrate Mothers Sunday today, it is good to note that mothers are shepherds, good ones indeed. They have unconditional and boundless love for their children. They provide emotional support, comfort and nurturing for their children and are always their safe space.

Mothers' love for their children are unwavering, regardless of their actions, thoughts, or feelings. This means that even when the child is misbehaving, a good mother will always love him or her and try to understand the underlying reason behind the behaviour. In this way, they provide their children a safe and supportive environment where they can thrive and grow. They attend to their physical, emotional, and psychological needs, ensuring they feel loved, valued, and respected.A good mother is nurturing and caring.
