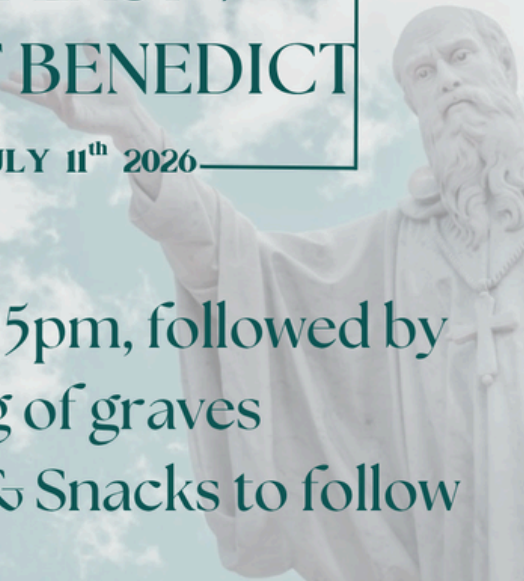

## 12<sup>th</sup> Sunday: Be my witnesses

In the Gospel Jesus calls for witnesses, that is, people who are not afraid to be seen to be his followers out there; in the midst of a sceptical and sometimes hostile world. Fear is one of the things that keeps Christians from a bold and generous witnessing to the Gospel.

A number of times in the Bible - Jesus told his apostles, 'Do not be afraid':

- Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, be afraid of the One who can destroy both soul and body in hell." (Matthew 10:28)
- Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid. Go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee; there they will see me." (Matthew 28:10)
- "I tell you, my friends, do not be afraid of those who kill the body and after that can do no more." (Luke 12:4-5)
- "Do not be afraid, little flock, for your Father has been pleased to give you the kingdom." (Luke 12:32)

An American teacher was employed in Japan on the understanding that during school hours he should not utter a word on the subject of Christianity. He kept faithfully to his promise.

He lived an exemplary Christian life before his students, but he never spoke a word to them about Christianity. After some years, his example became so compelling that unknown to him, forty of his students met secretly in a woods and signed a secret covenant to abandon Buddhism. Of these, 25 later entered the Kyoto Christian Training School and trained to go out and preach the Gospel which their teacher had made so attractive.

What this teacher did in Japan is very well put in a small poem which goes like this:

*"You are writing a Gospel,  
a chapter each day  
By the deeds that you do,  
and the words that you say.  
Men read what you write,  
if it's false or it's true.*

*Now what is the Gospel according to you?" ~ Tony Castle*

As we visit different places during summer, let us remember that every place needs Christian witnessing. Jesus told us, 'Witness to me before men' (Acts 1:8). In this world, we have to stand up and be counted as disciples of Jesus. It is not good enough to be low-level disciples of Christ. We have to give public witness to our Christian faith.

In some countries, like Northern Nigeria, to witness to Jesus Christ is to place one's life in danger. But, this is not the case in Canada. Although, we all would agree that Canada too need witnesses, because faith and Christian values are being eroded in this country. Though witnessing in Canada, one is more likely to face is not so much hostility or opposition, but something which is even harder - a deadly indifference. To witness in this case requires a special kind of courage. It means overcoming our fear of what people will think of us or say about us, and the fear of what it will cost us.

When Jesus said to his apostles, 'Do not be afraid,' he wasn't saying that they should never feel afraid. He knew that at times they would be afraid. The issue was what fear might do to them. It might paralyze them, or make them so diffident as to be unable to fulfil their mission. What Jesus did was to encourage them so that they might be able to move beyond fear.

How were they to overcome their fear? He urged them to have complete trust in God, who lovingly watches over the life and death of even the smallest of his creatures - the sparrows (Matthew 10:29).
