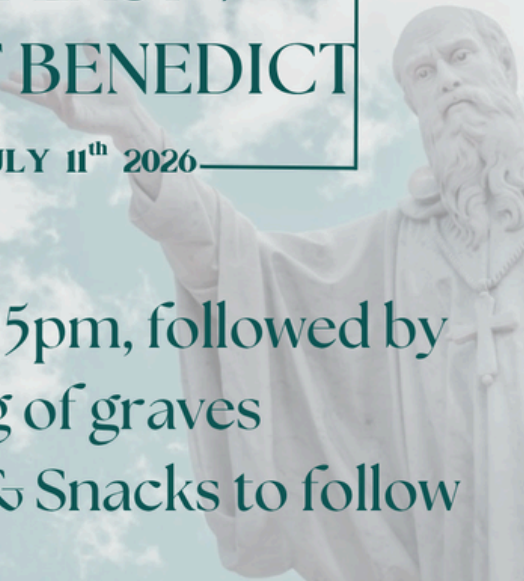

## 13<sup>th</sup> Sunday: Giving and Receiving

*“Every minute of every hour of every day you are making the world, just as you are making yourself, and you might as well do it with generosity and kindness and style.”* Rebecca Solnit

Christianity is a faith-inspiring adventure with Jesus Christ as the source and summit of every thought, words and actions. The cost of Christian discipleship should revolve around a delicate balance between a “sacrificial attitude or action undertaken in the name of Christ” and “with the right intention”.

Being a disciple of Jesus has both finite and infinite goals or temporal and permanent target. Christian discipleship, though, is geared towards ultimate happiness in heaven; has to overcome earthly challenges first - the demand of fostering a community of believers where love, respect, forgiveness, and understanding co-exist. One word that captures vividly this act of living and caring for each other is ‘generosity’.

Generous attitude is the soul and heart of Christian discipleship. A Chinese proverb says, “If you want happiness for an hour; take a nap. If you want happiness for a day; go fishing. If you want happiness for a year; inherit a fortune. If you want happiness for a lifetime; help someone else.”

The Shunammite woman knew nothing about Prophet Elisha prior to meeting him. Yet she intentionally invited him to her house, gave him something to eat. Our love, care and mercy need to be intentional and geared towards the well-being of the others.

This woman noticed Elisha’s needed shelter and she did something about it. She got her husband to cooperate in her generosity - “let us arrange a little room on the roof and furnish it for him with a bed, table, chair, and lamp, so that when he comes to us, he can stay there” (2 Kings 4:11).

This wealthy woman did not expect any reward from Elisha. Even when Elisha offered to do something for her, she politely declined, saying that she was satisfied with what she had (2 Kg 4:13), what an amazing person. She shared what she had and did not want reciprocation, not even the extra security of being linked up with the king as Elisha suggested. She was generous and contented.

Elisha, later learned through his servant Gehazi that the woman was childless. Prophet Elisha prophesied upon her, “About this time next year, you will hold a son in your arms” (2 Kings 4:16).

Henry B. Eyring said, “To find gratitude and generosity when you could reasonably find hurt and resentment will surprise you. It will be so surprising because you will see so much of the opposite: people who have much more than others yet who react with anger when one advantage is lost or with resentment when an added gift is denied.”

The Shunamite woman was generous, contented, and happy despite her share in life’s misfortune - childlessness. That was her cross which she bore patiently. Jesus said, “whoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me” (Mt 10:38).

Looking out for the needs of others despite our own crosses, despite our own misfortunes, that is the hall mark of Christian generosity. By serving Christ in our neighbour, we appear to lose our lives, but it is such service of Christ in others, that leads to contentment and happiness.
